Things to do and see while in Gothenburg:

Liseberg

The biggest amusement park in all of Scandinavia and the most popular attraction for visitors to Gothenburg.

Paddan

Tourist boats run in the city canals and in the harbor, among beautiful surroundings

Southern Archipelago

Visit the islands in the southern archipelago with regular passenger boats. These islands are car free and very picturesque. The boats go from the tram stop Saltholmen. Note that it is difficult to park there. Tram tickets are valid on the boat too.

Slottsskogen

A large English garden close to the Botanical Garden with a small zoo and old homestead houses.

Shopping

The main shopping center is Nordstan. It's located next to Brunnsparken and it is connected to the central train station. It has many outlets with international companies such as H&M & Esprit. Close to Nordstan is the smaller shopping center Arkaden, with a number of fashion boutiques.



Eating and Drinking in Gothenburg:

The main restaurant street in Gothenburg is Linnégatan running from Järntorget to Linnéplatsen. It has a high concentration of good restaurants of all kinds in the low to moderate price range

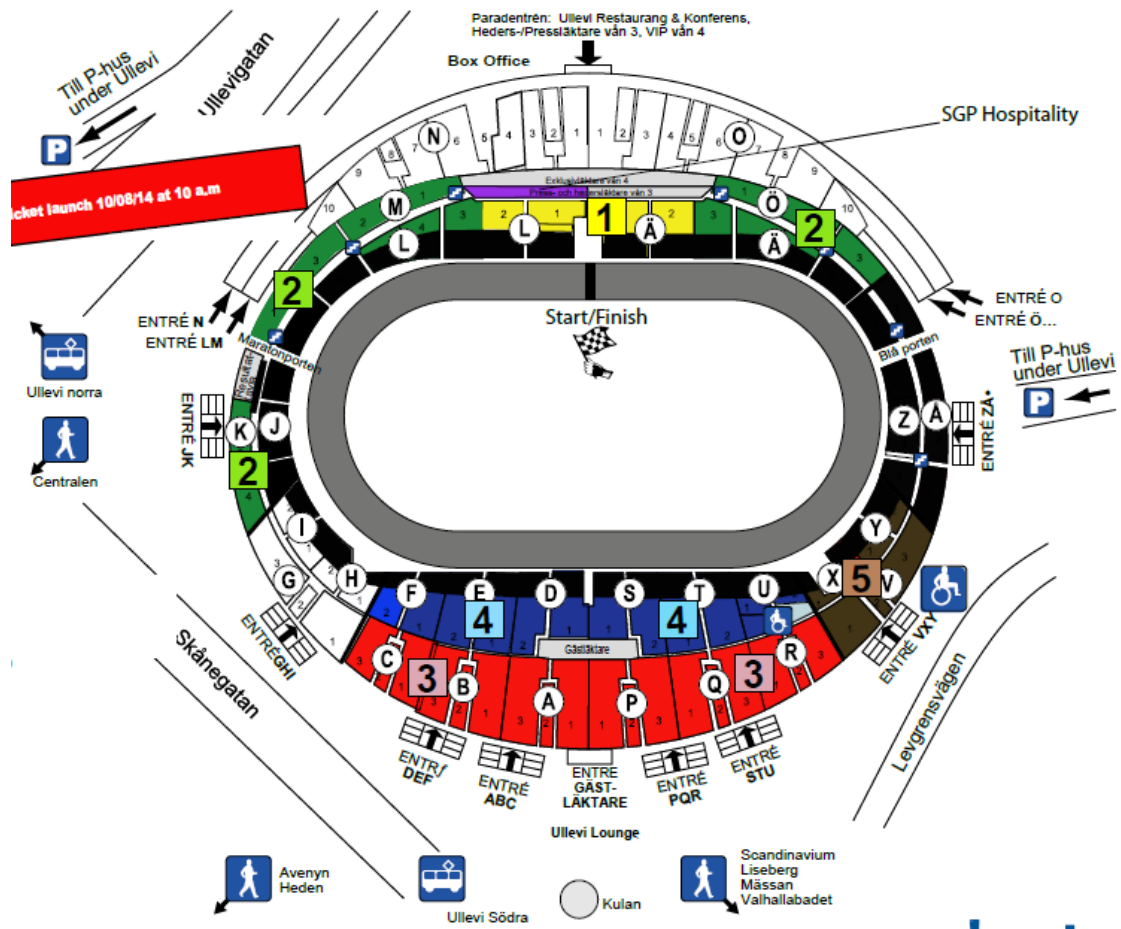
